AEPTO Meeting Minutes

August 22, 2013

I Call To Order:

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm.

II Approval of Minutes:

The minutes from the April and July 2013 meetings were passed out and the attendees were given time to read it. Both sets of minutes were approved by motion.

III Reports of Officers

President's Report: Please be reminded that meetings will begin on time. Treasurer's Report: A review of the AEPTO budget for the 2013-2014 academic year was presented. The current cash balance is \$62,684.83, and reflects a couple of field trip transportation costs incurred since the printing of the last budget report. Secretary's Report: A budgetary quote was presented from Heidi Faust to purchase clay from Runyan Pottery Supply in the amount of \$567.38. The treasurer approved this purchase.

IV 2013-2014 Budget Review

Each school (discussions led by present representatives) in consultation with the AEPTO board members reviewed each line item of the 2013-2014 budget. The following is a summary of those discussions and adjustments that were made. Line items that remain unchanged are not mentioned.

PS-Y5-K-1 (seven K, two PS, 2 Y5 and seven 1st grade teachers + 1 title)

- Kathleen Cranna (Hillcrest) suggested that all title teachers should be added to the budget (Team funds). The Treasurer indicated this would most likely not be a problem, but permission would first be needed. Lines 102 and 103 (19 teachers) was unchanged as a solution to support title.
- Line 105: is now for the Mount Pleasant Children's Museum.
- Kindergarten has requested a line item be added to support paper for language arts books. \$200 was removed from line 105 to create this new budgeted item.

• \$100 is being moved fro line 111 to line 110 to support increasing fees for science alive.

SECOND-THIRD GRADE (seven 2nd and seven 3rd grade teachers + 1.5 title)

- Lines 202 and 203 remain budgeted at 8 teachers each to support funding for title.
- Line 205 reduced to \$800.
- Line 207 (Impression 5) was increased to \$1500 by reducing line 205 by \$200 (to \$800), by reducing line 213 by \$50 (to \$750) and by eliminating line 210.

FOURTH-FIFTH GRADE (16 teachers (including title))

- Team funds not adjusted to accommodate title.
- Line 305 is being reduced by \$250 and added to line 311 because historical museum is now charging \$2 per student (per state funding cut).
- · Line 307: Loons field trip will now be renamed 5K day.

GENERAL

- Art Fund, line 403, is to be increased by \$100 (and removed from line 310).
- Family Fun Dance was not profitable in 2012-2013 school year, but should require no funding this year, and therefore no specific budget will be allotted.

V General Discussion

Kathleen Cranna suggested that the AEPTO minutes should be placed in take-home folders for parents to see - possibly attached to the school newsletters. In support, Luce Rd. and Pine indicated their newsletters go out on Fridays, Hillcrest's are sent on Mondays.
